Tickets go on sale June 9, 2017 at Noon AST

Georges Island and McNabs Island Programs, Tickets and Transport

Ticket holders for Georges Island events will depart from the Halifax Ferry Terminal while McNabs Island Picnic participants will depart from the Murphy's the Cable Wharf.

Food and beverage concessions will be available for purchase on Georges Island for the **Joel Plaskett Emergency & Port Cities Rock Georges Island** concert presented by Atlantic Lottery on July 29th which will also be a licensed event for ages 19 and over. People are also encouraged to take water (sealed bottles only), sunscreen, sun visors and other items as necessary. There will be a security bag search before boarding and alcohol is not permitted but available for purchase on-island.
